Purpose: To outline proper use of department mobile repeater located in Heavy Rescue.

Scope: Mobile repeater owned by Bristol Fire Department.

Responsibility: It is the responsibility all fire fighters to understand how to operate the mobile repeater.

Policy: All Fire Fighters will have proficiency in operating the mobile repeater.

Procedure:

- 1) Ensure Heavy Rescue is parked with engine running and master switch on.
- 2) Ensure mobile radio in Heavy Rescue is on and select channel on mobile radio that you want the mobile repeater to re-transmit out on.
- 3) Turn on mobile repeater by pushing the button labeled PWR on mobile radio.



4) When mobile repeater is on, there will be a "L' for on top of the display. There will be an "H" when it is off.



5) Verify repeater is on by confirming the unit located behind the rear set is powered up. No action needs to be taken with the repeater unit.



6) Select channel 15 (BFD Mobile RP) on your hand-held.

*** hand-held radio must be within normal transmission range of the mobile repeater for it to pick up transmissions from the hand-held and then re-transmit them through the mobile radio in Heavy Rescue.
